


Butterfly weed (p) Asclepias tuberosa, Early blooms, up to 1' Alternate: green milkweed (p) Asclepias viridis



Indian blanket (a) *Gaillardia pulchella,* up to 1' Deadhead for blooms all summer, Alternate: basketflower (a) *Centaurea americana*



Narrow-leaved coneflower (p) Echinacea angustifolia Blooms midsummer, 2-3' Alternate: Echinacea pallida or Echinacea purpurea (p)

Beebalm (p) *Monarda fistulosa,* Blooms midsummer, 2-4' Alternate: *Mondarda citridora* (a), *Monarda bradburiana* or *punctuata* (p)



Aromatic aster (p) Symphyotrichum oblongifolium, Blooms late summer/fall, 2-2.5' Alternate: Symphyotrichum praealtum/lateriflorum/ turbinellum (p)



Showy goldenrod (p) Solidago speciosa, Blooms late summer/fall, 2-3' Alternate: Solidago rigida/nemoralis/missouriensis (p)

Full Sun / Dry – Pollinator Garden Plan #2



Autumn sage (p) *Salvia greggii,* Blooms early and again in late summer through fall, woody shrub 3x3'

Alternate: Shrubby St. John's Wort (p) Hypericum prolificum



Gaura (p) *Oenothera lindheimeri,* Blooms all summer, 2x2', Comes in pink or white

(p) - perennial

Foxglove beardtongue (p) Penstemon digitalis, Blooms spring, 2' Alternate: 'husker's red' variety or Penstemon grandiflorus



Threadleaf bluestar (p) Amsonia hubrichtii, Blooms spring, 2' Alternate: Amsonia tabernaemontana or Amsonia illustris (p)




Coreopsis lanceolata (p), Blooms summer deadhead for continuous blooms, 2'

Mexican hat (p) *Ratibida columnifera* Blooms summer, 2' Alternate: *Ratibida pinnata* (p)

(a) - annual (p) – perennial






Beautyberry (p) Callicarpa americana,Late boneset (p)Woody shrub with ornamental berries in fall,Eupatorium serotinumcut back end of winter for compact growth, Fall blooms, dense clusters of small3-5x3-4'white flowers, 2-3'S-3'



Plain's oval sedge (p) *Carex brevior* Hardy drought tolerant, grows 1-1.5' tall, stays green year round

Columbine (p) Early blooms, about 2' tall



Woodland phlox (p) *Phlox divaricate* Bright purple-y blooms in spring, 1x1' Alternate: pigeonberry (p)



Violet (a/p) *Viola*, Dainty heart-shaped leaves, light purple flowers early spring, 6-10 in tall

Part Shade / Medium-Dry - Pollinator Garden #2 (p) - perennial




Coralberry (p) Symphoricarpos orbiculatus, Delicate woody shrub produces berries in fall, can be cut back end of winter for compact growth, 3x3'



Purple meadowrue (p) *Thalictrum dasycapum* Delicate feathery leaves, purplish stems with creamy green flowers in spring, 2-3'



Frostweed (p) Verbesina virginica White flowers in fall, at first frost stems exude water that freezes into fascinating shapes, 2x4'




Blue-stemmed goldenrod (p) Solidago caesia, Smooth purplish, arching stems with yellow flowers, blooms late fall, 1-3'



White snakeroot (p) *Ageratina altissima*, Flat-topped clusters of small fuzzy white flower heads, attracts a wide variety of pollinators, mid-late summer blooms, 2-4'



Wild strawberry (p) *Fragaria virginiana* ground-hugging plant that will spread with stolons, flowers are small and bloom early spring, fruit is small and gone quickly
